The spirit of this fund has come alive for our girls throughout our campus and we've collected a few examples that show how BSS is leveraging this resource to create awe-inspiring experiences for our students.

ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT

DESIGN THINKING

When Middle School Principal Ian Rutherford identified the need to increase Design Thinking and its application at the middle school level – he turned to the Innovation Fund to make it happen... then he asked for a cordless drill. Well, not just the drill.

Design Thinking is a fancy way of saying that students are learning to use all of their resources – data, technology, experience, instinct, empathy, creativity – to solve complex problems. It's a highly-valued skillset in today's economy and has applications in almost every kind of problem-solving you can imagine.

Design Thinking is on full display in the new Middle School Design/Tech Lab, stocked with power tools, technology and an array of disconnected objects, that inspire students to create things like their own water filters or a Rube Goldberg machine. Learning should always be this fun.

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

VISITING HARVARD UNIVERSITY

Two Junior School teachers, Radhika Raj and Ron Whaling, were able to visit Project Zero at Harvard University and access research-based teaching practices that promote critical thinking, curiosity and creativity. Project Zero has collaborated with and been inspired by the work of Reggio-Emilia and, as a result, the research and key concepts are aligned with the school's pedagogy and practice. Radhika and Ron have been sharing their experience with their colleagues as well as implementing the strategies and approaches from Project Zero in our classrooms.

VISITING SCHOLARS

DR. JANE GOODALL

How exciting to sit in a room with the magnificent Dr. Jane Goodall talking about her experiences as a world-renowned scientist, activist and humanitarian. That's what the students from Grades 6 through 12 were able to do and it was a remarkable experience for them. They saw in Dr. Goodall a woman who represents everything the *Signature of a BSS Girl* aspires to, and it sparked their enthusiasm for a future in which they can see themselves as leaders in the same spirit.

ANNUAL FUND

We are celebrating the successful conclusion of the *Intersection* campaign, but the process of renewal, innovation and learning is never finished. We rely on the BSS Annual Fund to be the ongoing resource that gives BSS its extra edge. If everyone participates with a contribution to the Annual Fund, no matter how big or small, we can continue offering life-changing experiences for our students.

JUNIOR SCHOOL ATELIER

A space for young learners to gather in small groups and use artistic and expressive languages to explore science, math and social studies in a connected way. Annual Fund resources helped create this space and hopefully, will continue to support its development through the addition of new tools and the creation of ‘pop-up’ ateliers that can be moved around to different areas.

GRADE 9 TRANSITION DAY

What is the purpose of having an expert facilitator customize a day of exploration in which Grade 9 girls can focus on emotional development and their shared experiences? It’s an example of BSS going the extra mile to help girls adjust to a new developmental stage, and encourage them as a team to take care of one another and treat each other with respect. The session was an enormous success and the participants emerged with new tools for communicating, empathizing and connecting with each other.



TOGETHER, WE’VE COME FULL CIRCLE

No matter how far our graduates go in their lives, they will always be part of an unbreakable circle of support in the BSS family.

Now more than ever, BSS Old Girls have connected with their school and each other in growing numbers. Perhaps that’s why the Full Circle Project has been such a success. Nearly 700 names adorn the Full Circle balustrade in the new wing’s atrium, a tribute to the spirit that lives on in our Old Girl community.
